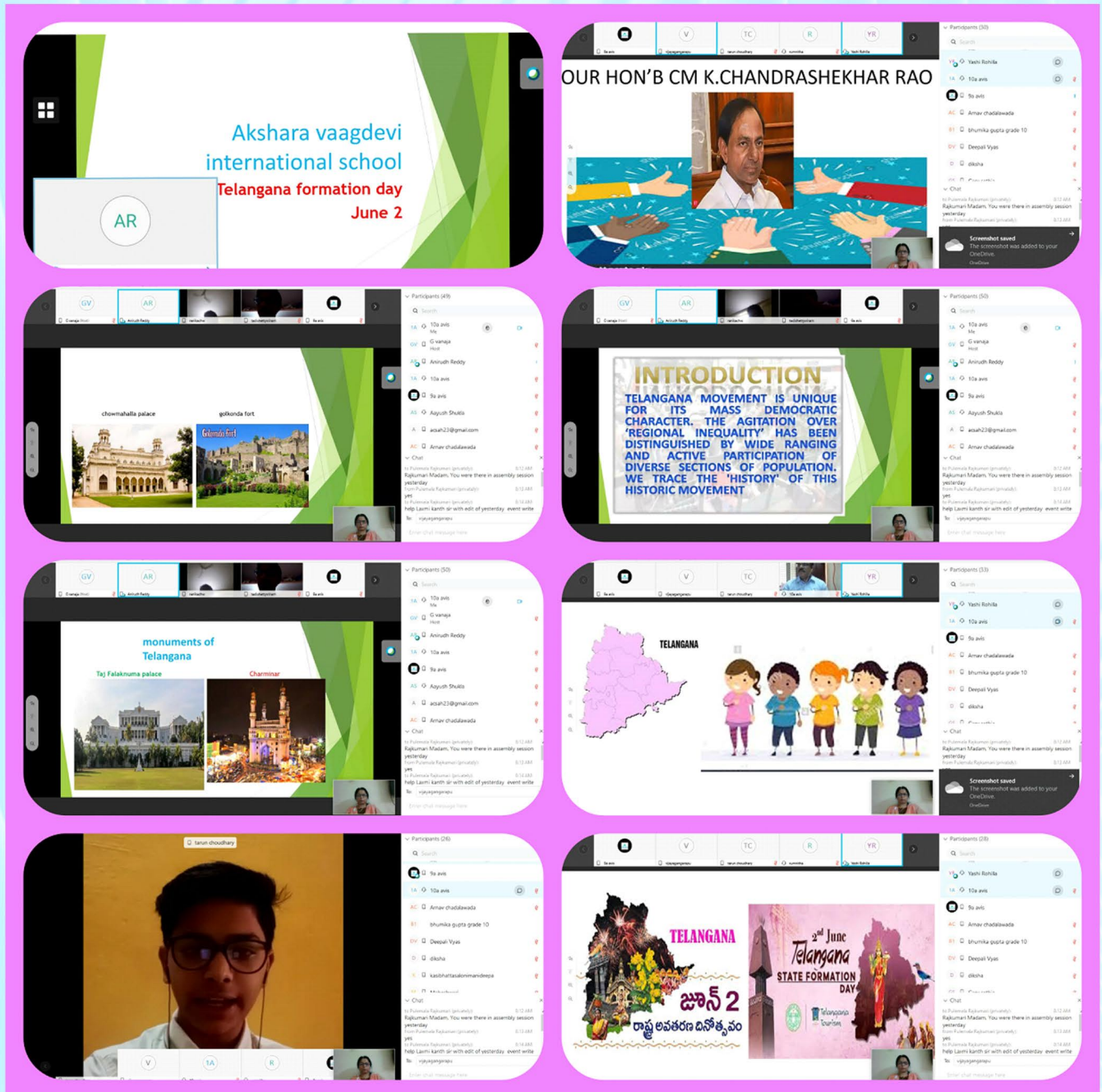
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SAFE KIDS AND HAPPY KIDS- WEBINAR BY Dr SUMAN

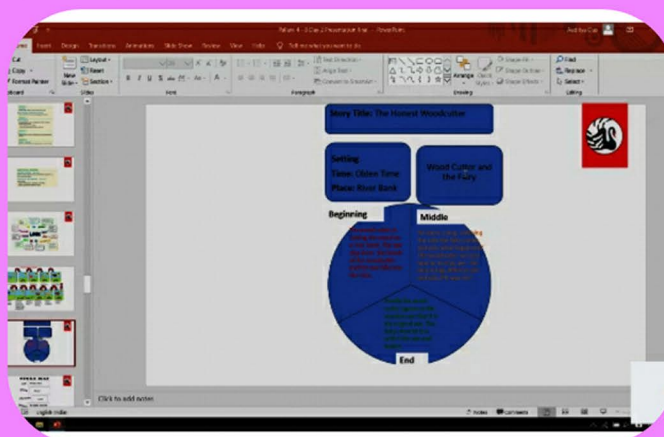
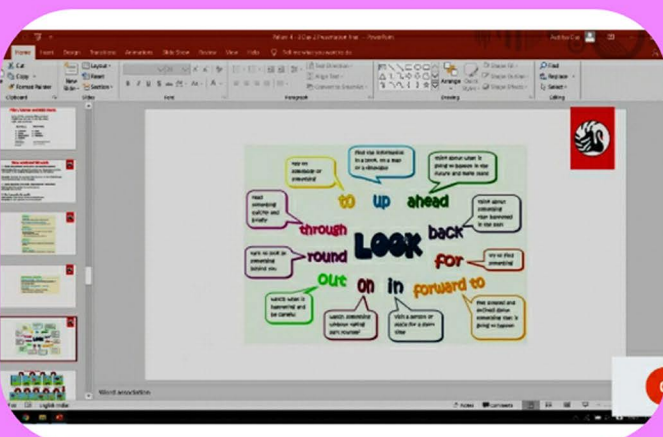
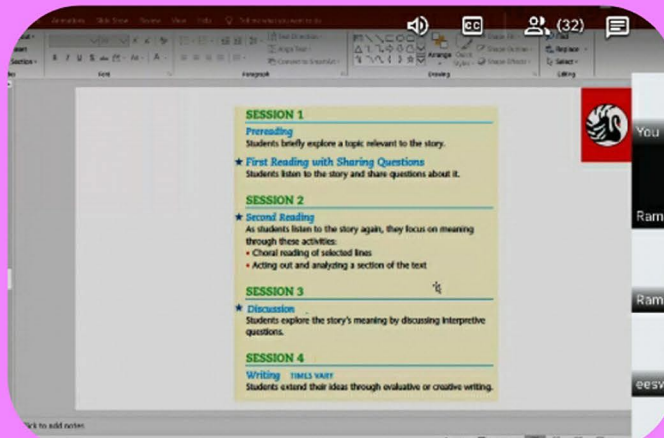
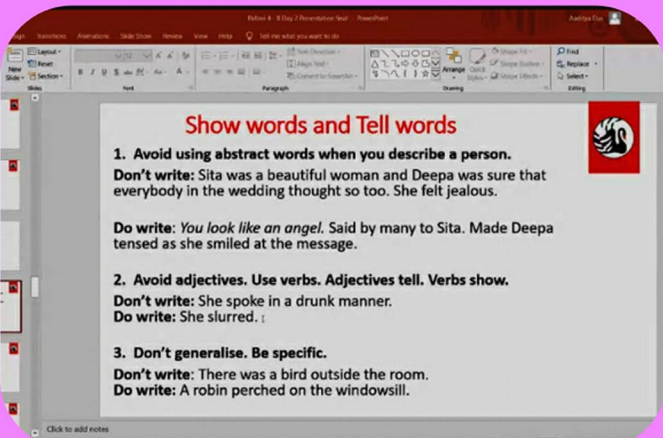
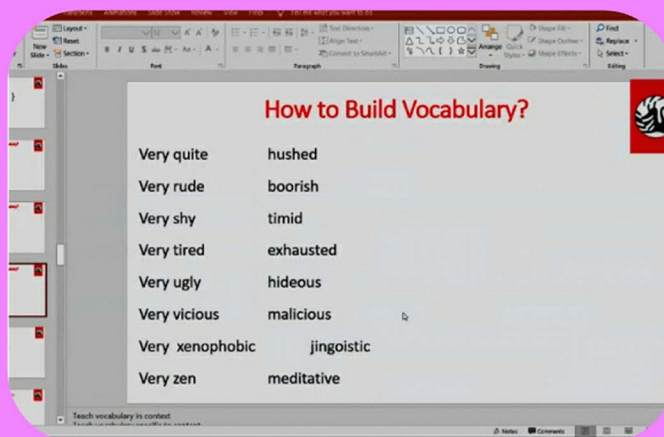
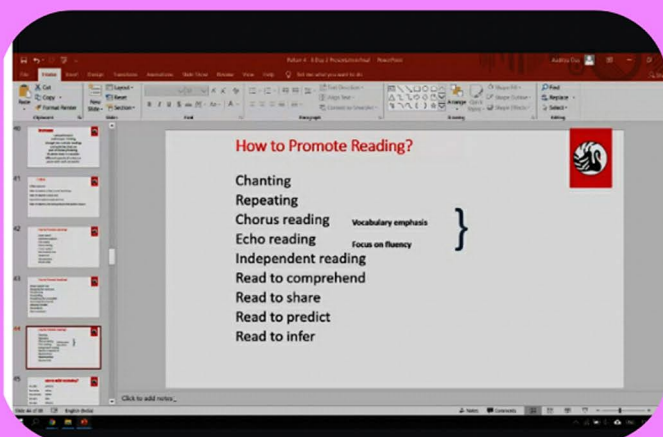
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NURTURING 21st CENTURY SKILLS- 4th JUNE 2020

NATIONAL READING DAY- 19TH JUNE 2020

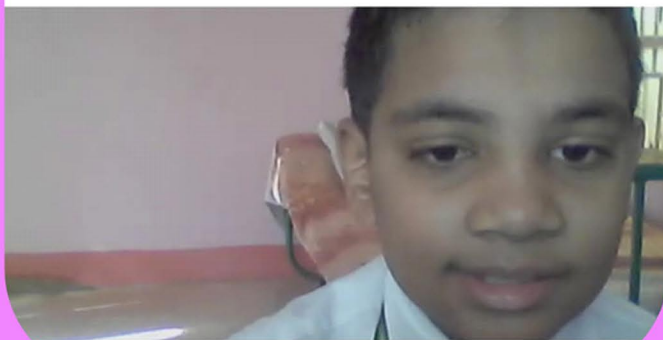

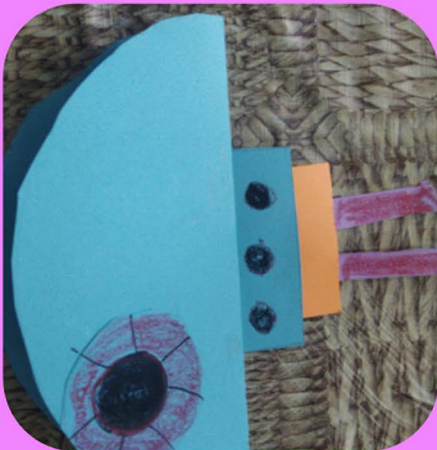
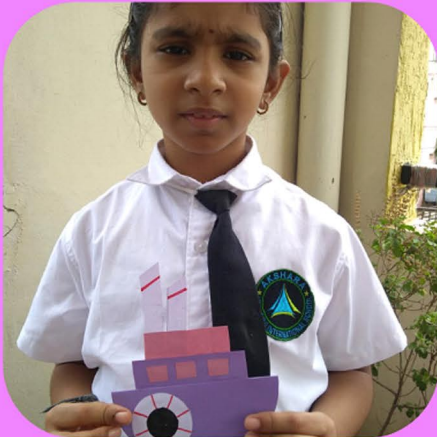
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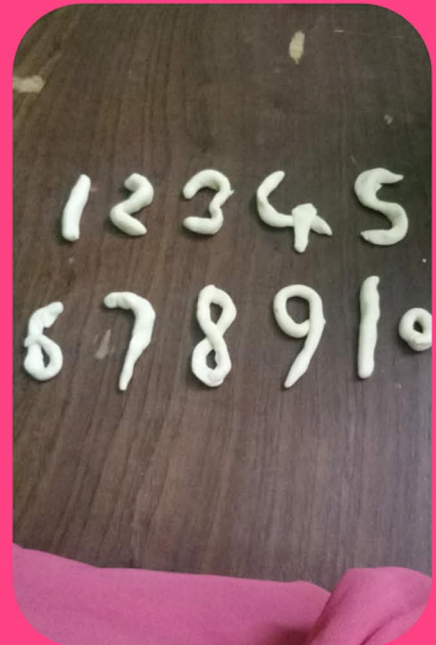
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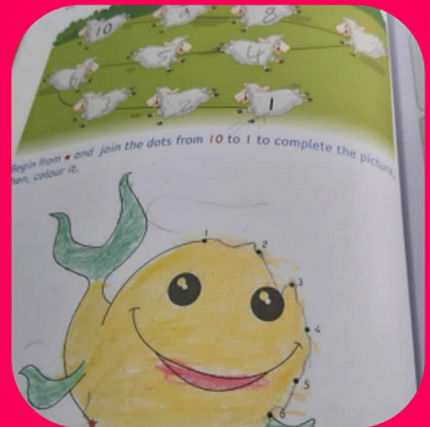
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RED COLOUR DAY- PRE-PRIMARY 30TH JUNE 2020

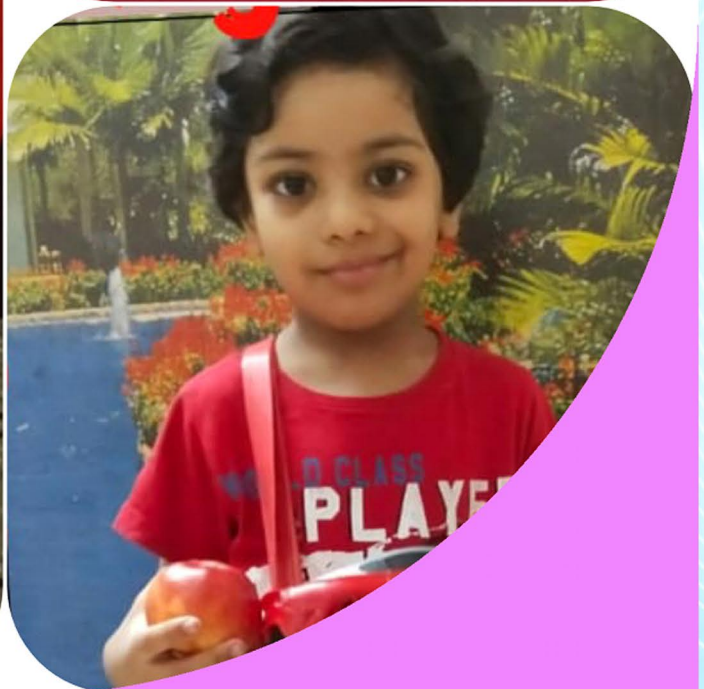
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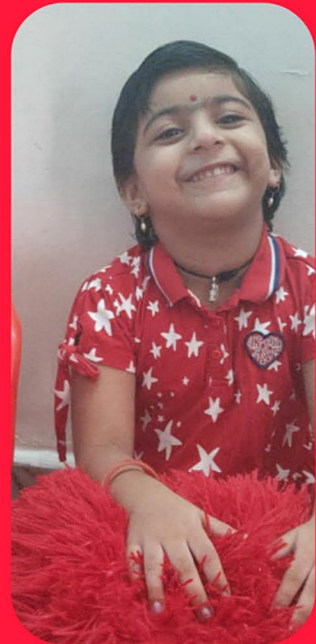
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STORYBOARD - SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY
