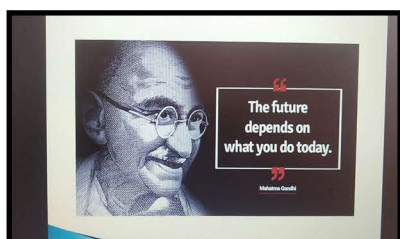
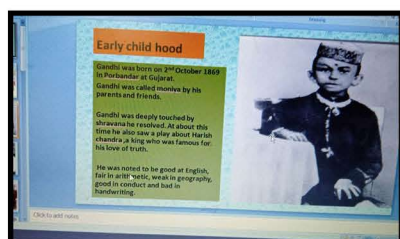
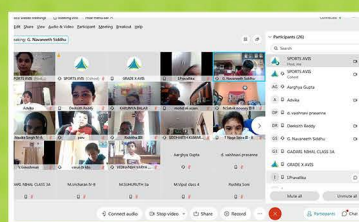


OPEN HOUSE FOR GRADES I TO IV

BEST OUT OF WASTE -GRADES I TO X

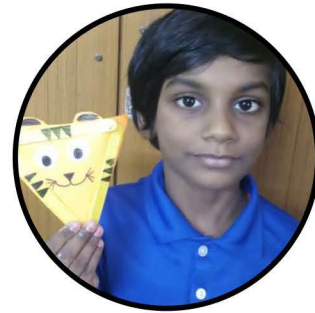

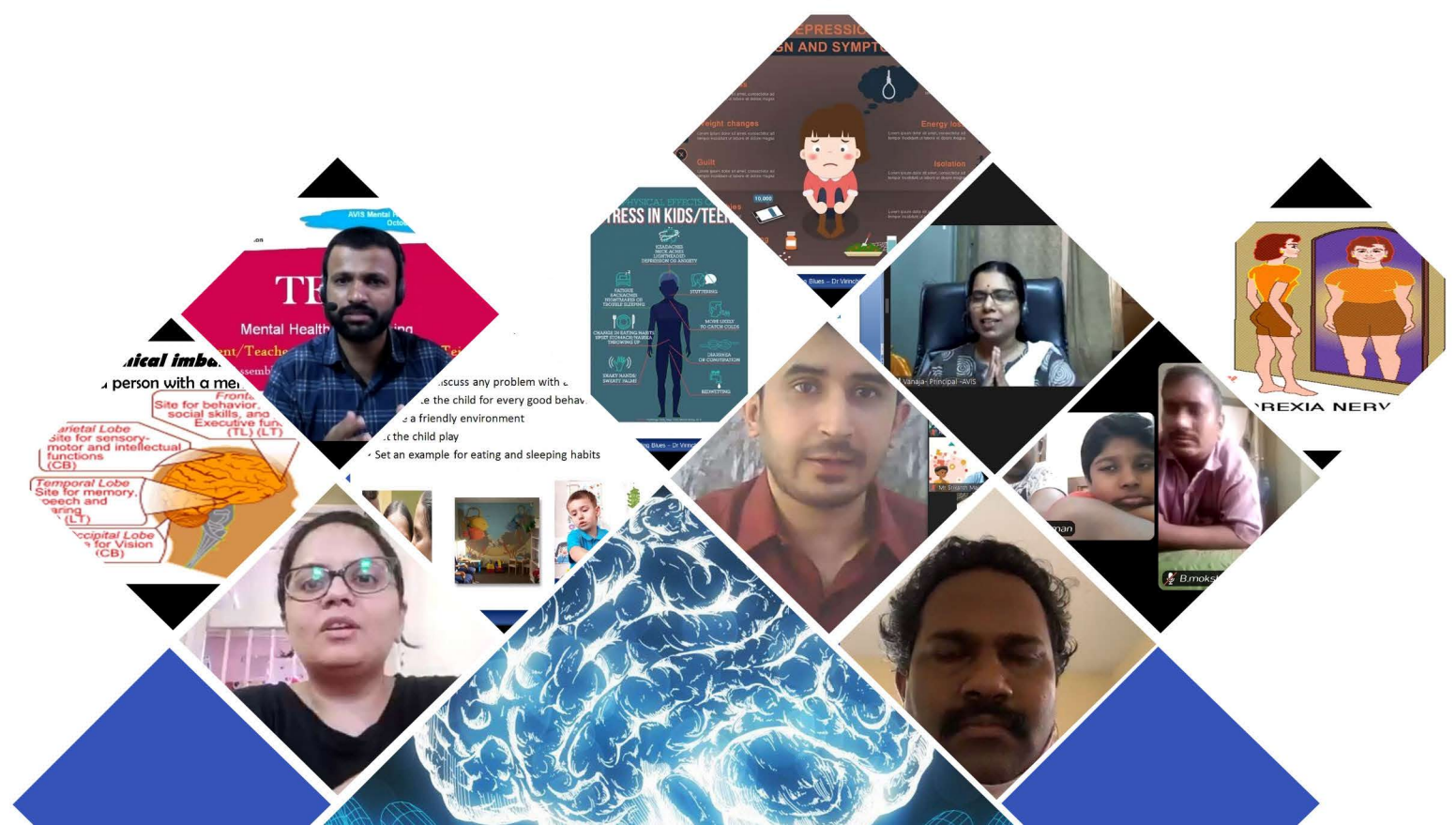
MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS WEEK-DR.VIRINCHI SHARMA

10th OCTOBER-PTM -GRADES I TO V

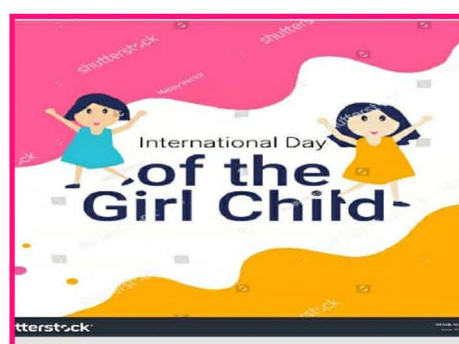
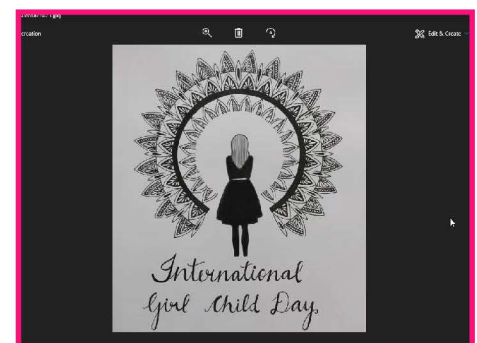
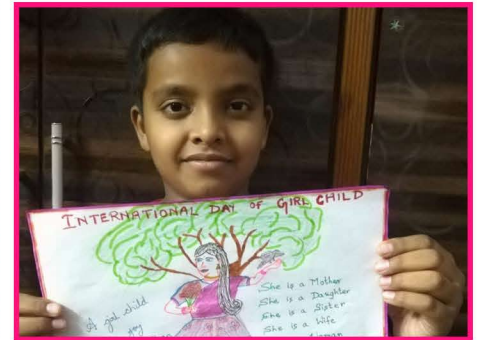
PTM was conducted for Grades I to V. It was a good interaction session between the parents and the teachers. The parents were briefed about their wards academic performance

GIRL CHILD DAY-GRADES-V to X

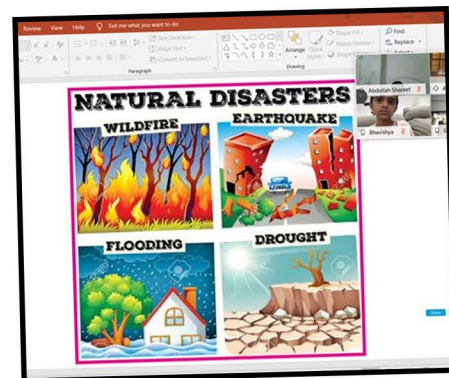
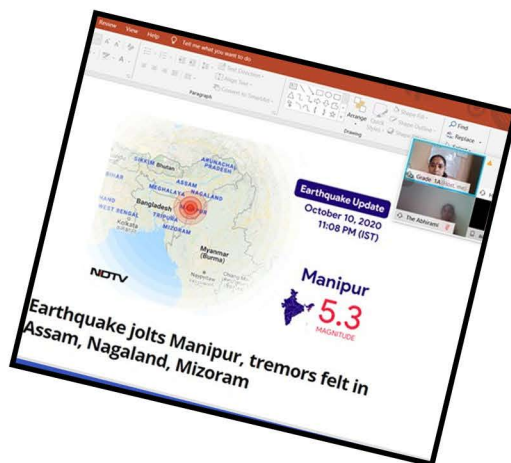
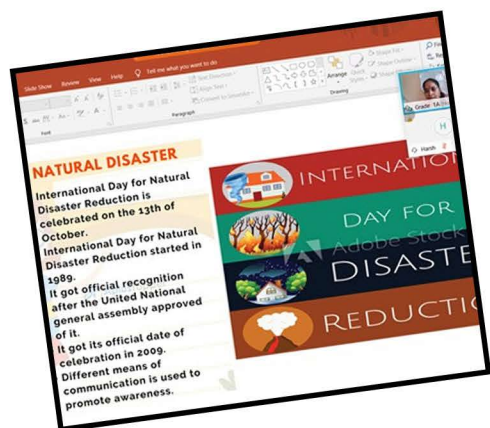

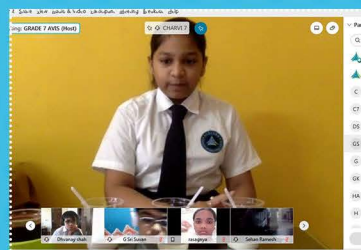
NATURAL DISASTER REDUCTION-GRADES-VI to X

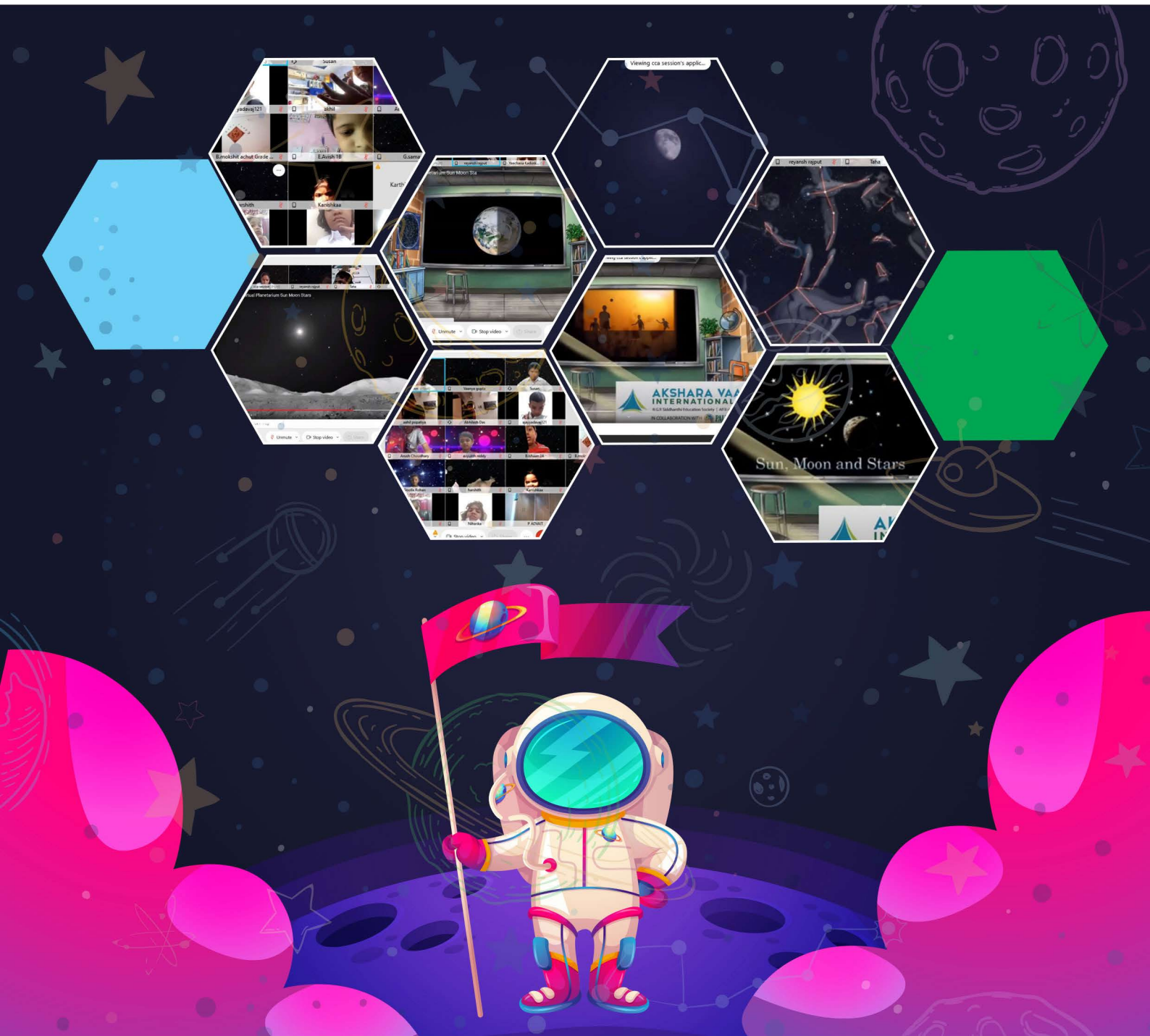


TO A FANTASY WORLD

31st OCTOBER -FIELD TRIP (SCIENCE)-GRADES -I to IV

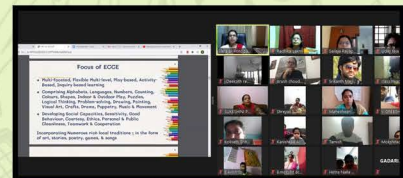
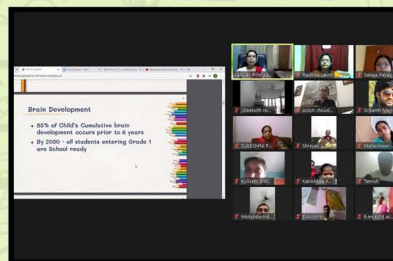
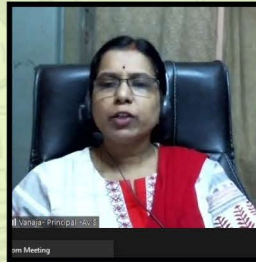
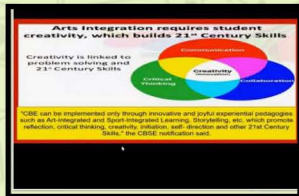
