
"MATHEMATICS IS THE BIGGEST MOTIVATION BECAUSE IT STARTS FROM ZERO AND GOES UP TO INFINITY."

UNESCO proclaimed March 14 as the International Day of Mathematics on the 40th session of the General Conference on November 26, 2019. Founded in 1988 by physicist Larry Shaw, March 14 was selected because the numerical date (3.14) represents the first three digits of pi, and it also happens to be Albert Einstein's birthday—the perfect pi-incidence. March 14 is celebrated in many countries as Pi Day because that date is written as 3/14 in some countries and the mathematical constant Pi is approximately 3.14.

Pi (Greek letter " π ") is a symbol in mathematics to represent a constant (3.14) approximately.

Students of Grade IX and X participated in the celebrations in the school premises by speaking on the importance of the day and the importance of the constant used in different mathematical concepts. Sania Firdose of grade IX presented a powerpoint on the importance of the day. Colourful Charts and wall papers were also presented by students. The usage of the word Pie in literature was also well explained by the students. It was a great opportunity for students to explore pi and math-related concepts.
