The process of proper stream selection is important. When a student is in class 10, he/she should start exploring his/her interests and making career plans. First step is to identify the child's interests and strengths. A child who is interested in science, mathematics, and logical reasoning may opt for science stream, while one interested in economics, business, and commerce may opt for commerce stream. Similarly, a child who loves languages, arts, and social sciences may opt for the humanities stream. Once the students have identified the child's interests and strengths, it is important to discuss the pros and cons of each stream. For example, science stream may provide more career options, but it may require more effort and hard work. Commerce stream may offer a better understanding of business, but it may not provide as many career options as science. Humanities stream may provide more flexibility, but it may not offer as many lucrative career options as science or commerce.

As career counsellors Ms Indira Ashok Sr Faculty of English, Ms Priyanka of Physics, Ms Sreelatha of Chemistry, Ms Uma Padmaja of Biology Mr Ashwin Sharma CA of Accountancy and Ms Sindhu of Physical Education from Pallavi model school Bwply branch gave a briefing on the challenge of suggesting the right stream to a student.

Our Principal Mam Ms Vanaja said that their own challenges and opportunities are important to let the child make an informed decision based on their interests and aspirations.
