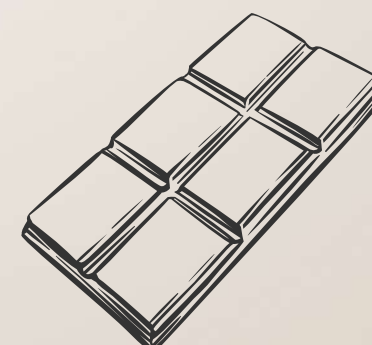




A Joyful Journey into the World of Chocolates

At AVIS, we take education seriously, and nothing, not even inclement weather, will stand in the way of our students' learning journey!

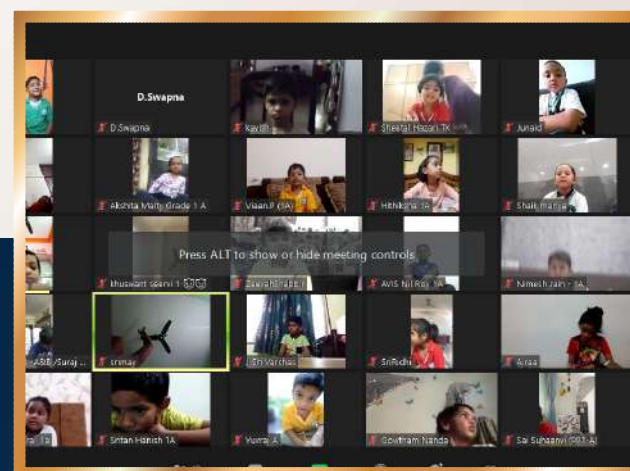
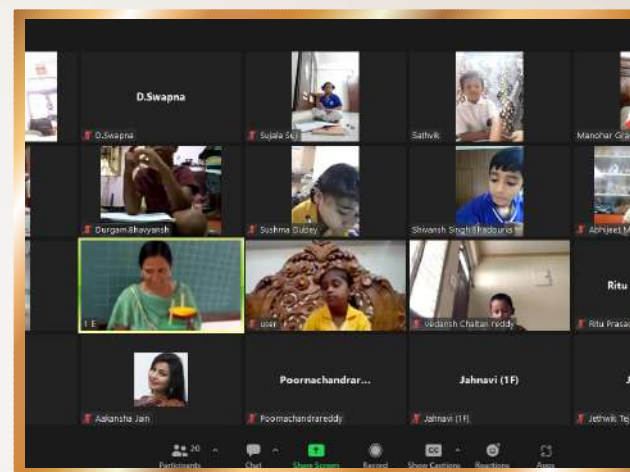
