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"INTER SCHOOL AAVIRBHAV COMPETITION"

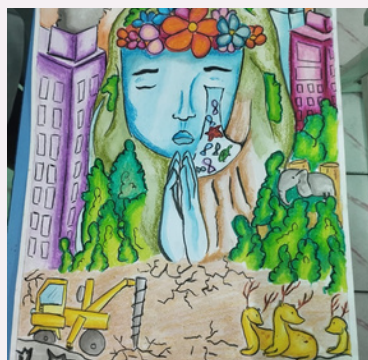

"NATIONAL HANDLOOM DAY"



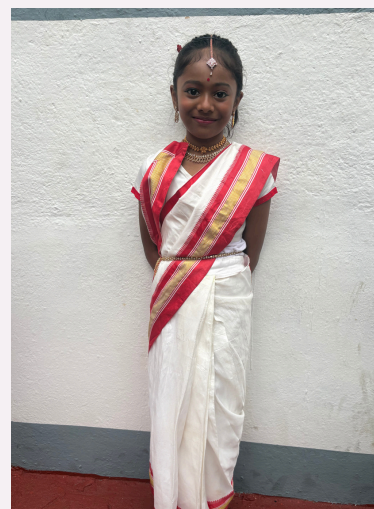
