Dear Parents,
Greetings from AVIS!

We are delighted to introduce the **PARP – Pick A Reading Partner Program**, a joyful school-wide initiative designed to promote meaningful reading habits and strengthen the reading bond between children and their parents or guardians.

Under this program, parents, grandparents, or older siblings are encouraged to spend 15 minutes per day for 5 days a week, over a span of 3 weeks, reading with their child at home.

This month's theme is "Wild About Reading."

Objectives:

- To develop fluency, comprehension, and pronunciation in reading.
- To nurture curiosity and joy for books and stories.
- To strengthen parent-child connection through shared reading experiences.

Parent Guidelines:

- Read with your child for 15 minutes daily, 5 days a week.
- Choose age-appropriate books, newspapers, or magazines.
- Make reading time enjoyable—avoid pressure or correction during reading.
- Discuss the story by asking simple questions like:
 - "What do you think will happen next?"
 - "Which character do you like most?"
- Support your child in completing the weekly activities and reading logs.

Wild Reading Weekly Activity list

Note: All the activities will be set up and guided by the teachers in class. The "Wild Recipes" activity will be a collaborative home activity to be prepared by the students along with their parents.

Week 1 activities:

Due date: 10/11/2025

1. Create Your Own Robot Character
 - Materials required: Empty tin can, plastic bottle, paper box, or carton
 - Decorative items: pom-poms, pipe cleaners, yarn, stickers, etc.
2. Word Search – "Book Adventure"
3. Word Scramble – "Story Characters"
4. Wild Recipe- Rainbow Fruit Chaat



- Ingredients: Pomegranate seeds, apple, banana, orange, chaat masala, lemon juice, salt
- Instructions:
 - a. Cut apple, banana, and orange into small pieces.
 - b. Mix with pomegranate seeds.
 - c. Squeeze lemon juice over the fruit.
 - d. Sprinkle chaat masala and salt lightly.
 - e. Toss gently and eat while discussing your book!

Week 2 activity list:

Due date: 17/11/2025

1. Submit pledge forms, reading log 2, discuss activities completed.
2. Crack the Code – "Secret Message"
3. Sing and listen
Karaoke sessions where adults listen or sing along.
4. Wild Recipe - Quick Lassi.



- Ingredients: Yogurt, water (or milk), sugar (or salt), cardamom powder (optional), ice cubes
- Instructions:
 - Blend 1 cup yogurt with ½ cup cold water (or milk)
 - Add 2 tablespoons sugar and a pinch of cardamom powder or Add ¼ teaspoon salt and a pinch of cumin powder (optional)
 - Blend until smooth and frothy
 - Pour into glasses and add ice cubes
