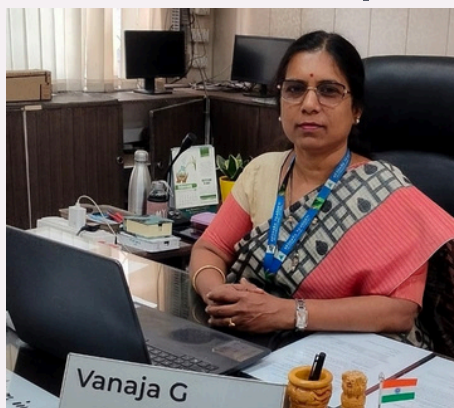

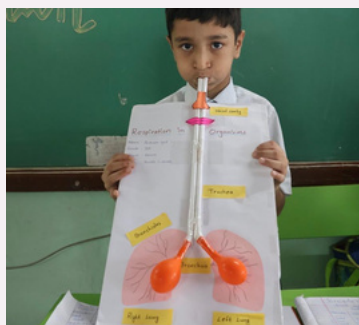

"CBSE READING CHALLENGE"



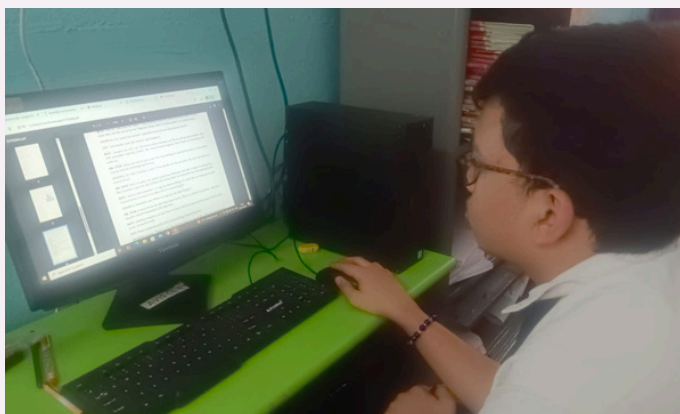
